
As industry and community leaders, Rachlin's commitment to UM/Sylvester is a strong and powerful endorsement and is critical to our growth. We have invested your gift toward the recruitment and retention of world-class physicians and scientists and in funding their cutting edge research.

In the past year, UM/Sylvester has recruited 19 outstanding physician-scientists to its ranks, including renowned breast cancer specialists Marc Lippman and Mark Pegram. Dr. Lippman is recognized as a pioneer in studying the role of estrogen in breast cancer. He developed the first system that allowed researchers to stimulate cells with estrogen outside the body, a breakthrough that allowed extensive testing of estrogen at the molecular level. Dr. Lippman is particularly interested in further developing experimental therapeutics and drugs design for breast cancer patients.

Dr. Pegram's research focuses on understanding the molecular pathways that regulate how HER-2 signals cell growth. He was a co-investigator on the landmark research and clinical trials that led to the development of Herceptin, the first FDA approved targeted therapy for use in early stage HER-2 positive breast cancers. Drs. Lippman and Pegram are leaders in the clinic and in the laboratory— and Rachlin helped to bring them to UM/Sylvester.

We are grateful for Rachlin Foundation's commitment to our South Florida community— and to our area's only academic cancer center— UM/Sylvester. Here's to many more years together!
